- 1. The Organising Authority is the Sailing Development Group of the Adelaide Sailing Club**
- 2. Eligibility**
 - 2.1. The Regatta is open to all Junior and Youth sailors aged between 7 and 18 at 1/9/16
 - 2.2. All sailors must be current members of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
 - 2.3. Green fleet sailors enrolled in the Sailing School FPT course will be deemed members of Adelaide Sailing Club for the FPT Regatta.
- 3. Safety**
 - 3.1. A member of the Race Committee may stop a boat launching or request a boat to return to shore if he or she considers the boat, its equipment, helm or crew not adequate for the likely conditions. Such boats may be scored DNC, DNS or DNF as appropriate.
 - 3.2. Each competitor shall wear a securely fastened adequate personal buoyancy at all times whilst afloat. This amends Rule 40.
 - 3.3. Penalties for breaches of rule 41 (Outside Help) shall be at the discretion of the Race Committee. Actions taken purely in the interest of Safety will not be penalized. This changes RRS rule 41.
- 4. Class Flags**
 - 4.1. Opti Cup will be the Opti Flag
 - 4.2. Tillett Trophy will be the Cadet Flag – White flag with Blue C
 - 4.3. O’pen BIC Cup. will be the Bic Flag – White flag with Black insignia
 - 4.4. Peterson Trophy will be the 420 flag – White flag with blue 420.
 - 4.5. The Green Fleet will, be a green flag
- 5. The Start / Finish**
 - 5.1. The starting line shall be between a buoy carrying an orange flag on the port end and a staff carrying an orange flag on the Committee Boat on the starboard end.
 - 5.2. The finishing line shall be between a buoy carrying a blue flag on the port end and a staff carrying a blue flag on the Committee Boat on the starboard end.
 - 5.3. The starting and finishing lines shall be opposite sides of the Committee boat.
 - 5.4. Start sequence rule 26 shall be used.
 - 5.5. Start sequence for the first start shall be as described on the Notice Board on lower level of the club
 - 5.6. The start sequence for subsequent starts may be in a different order from the first start.
- 6. Time Limit**
 - 6.1. The time limit for the first boat to finish shall be 75 minutes. Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat finishes shall be scored Did Not Finish. This changes rules 35 and A4.1.
 - 6.2. After at least one boat has completed the course and finished tail end boats may be finished on course and directed to the start line for another race.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A shall apply.
- 7.2. One race is required to constitute a series.
- 7.3. Up to 6 races are scheduled. If 4 or more races are completed a yacht's best 3 races will count, if less than 4 races are completed all completed races will count.

8. Protests

- 8.1. A boat intending to protest must advise the Race Committee boat at the finish of the race.
- 8.2. Protests must be lodged to the Race Officer within 30 minutes of the finish of the last boat in the last race of the day.
- 8.3. Protests may be resolved through arbitration

9. Coaching

- 9.1. Coaching is permitted within the Green Fleet.
- 9.2. Coaches will be appointed by ASC Sailing Development Committee.
- 9.3. All other support craft must stay at least 50 m from any racing yacht unless directed by the Race Officer.

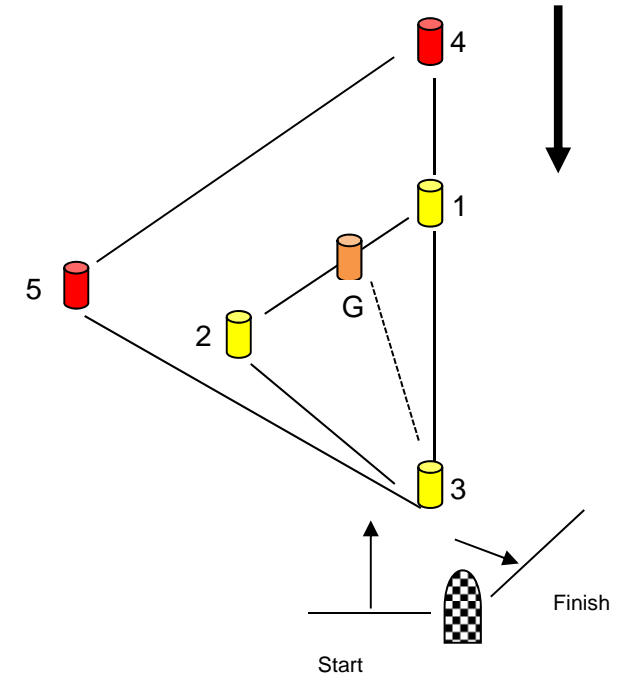
10. Disclaimer of Liability

- 10.1. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, 'Decision to Race'. The organizing authority or its servants will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. Prizes

- 11.1. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
